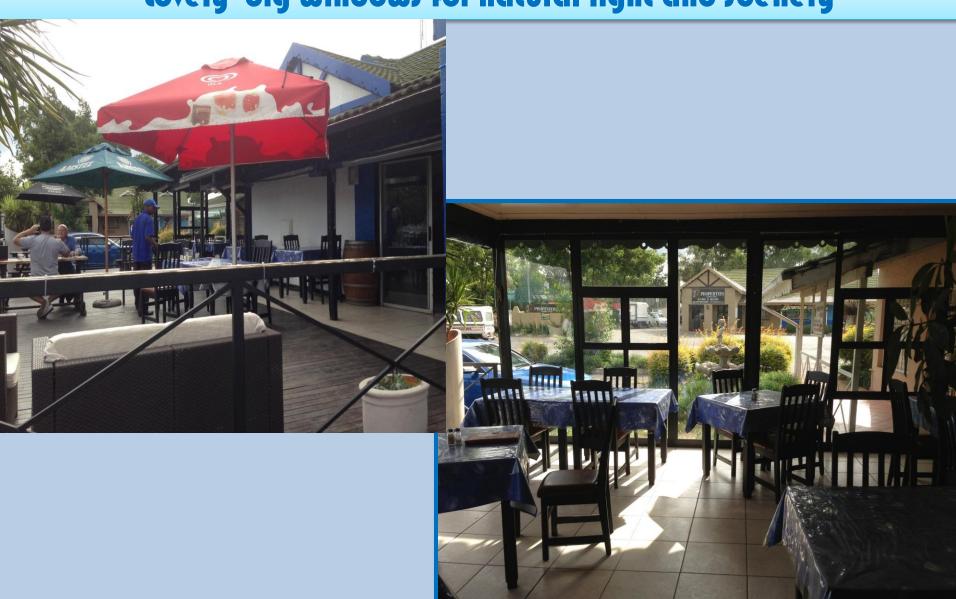

An amount of R17 000.00 (Seventeen Thousand Rand) is payable per month for the first Year. In the Second year an amount of R22 000.00 is payable per month. And in the years following, a 10% increase per year.

#### **Lease Period**

## **NOTES**

- Demonstration Greek Café has only been operational since Aug 2012.
- That being the case, the achieved sales and profit figures are relatively low, because it is early days and the restaurant is becoming better and better known, and figures are increasing month by month.
- For valuation purposes we have used the figures achieved during October, November, and December 2012.
- Considering the prime location and huge potential to grow exponentially, with the available space, as well as it being relatively unknown presently, the value of this business would be taken at a multiple of 3 years net profit.
- Because October November December are the best 3 trading months, we are reducing the value by 40%.
- Assets of the business are valued at R514,850.00 and stock is valued at R67 581.51 both of which are included in the value of the business.
- The reduction of 40% of the value of the business is again being ultra conservative because, the business had been valued in the early days of the business's existence, and as the business becomes more known, turnovers are going to increase substantially.

## Valuation

- Total Net profit for 3 months October, November, December 2012 = R 231,736.74
- Annualised = R926,946.96
- 3 years Nett Profit and value of business = R2.78million.
- Reduced by 40% = true value of the business = R1.67million.

## Conclusion

The valuation of R1.67million is an extremely conservative valuation and very good value for money
